

Dangerous Faith: A Daily Proclamation: (Revised 08/30/26)

I am grateful to the One who called me out of darkness – the God who extended to me a gift of righteousness. He set me free from the law of sin and death and brought me into the Kingdom of the Son He loves. I have been justified; I have been sanctified; and I have been declared righteous, not by anything I have done, but by the shed blood of Jesus Christ. My sins, which have been many, have been placed far away, as far as the East is from the West; as far as one nail-pierced hand to the other; and my God remembers them no more.
